

Scientific Publication Ethic

The Journal staff of «Bulletin Samara State Agricultural Academy» follows the Publication Ethic principles adopted by the international society, reflected, in particular, in recommendations issued by the Committee for Publication Ethic, the Guidance for Scientific Publication Ethic by Elsevier and the Scientific Publication Ethic Code.

Professional Ethic conduct for the Editor and Publisher

The editor is responsible for giving to the public the copyrighted works, which results in necessity to mind the following fundamental principles:

- While adopting a decision for publishing the Editor of a scientific Journal is guided by the correct interpretation of data and the scientific value of any work under the consideration.
- The Editor is to value the intellectual content of copies no matter of what race, sex, sexual orientation, religious outlook, origin, citizenship, social status and Author's political preference.
- Data not published obtained from copies submitted for consideration, are forbidden for both either individual use or transfer to the third parties without written Author' authorization. Any information or ideas, got during editing and related to possible advantages are to be kept in secret and not used to accrue own profit.
- The Editor is not to give the information for publication in case grounds are found sufficient to consider it a plagiary.
- The Editor together with the Publisher are not to leave without reply any claims related to either the copies considered or materials published as well as identifying the conflict situation and take all measures required to restore the Right that has been infringed.

Ethic principles for Reader's activity

A Reader carries out an expertise of copyrighted works based on lack of bias, involving the following behavior manners:

- The copy obtained for reading is to be considered as confidential property and not allowed to be transferred for awareness and further dispute by the third party possessing no publisher's empowerment.
- A Reader is to give an equitable and well founded reason for the mark of the research results submitted. Any individual comments in regard to the Author are not admitted.
- Any data not selected for publication and taken from copy submitted are not to be used by the Reader for own purpose and advantage.
- The Reader who doesn't possess as to his mind good experience to give the copy's mark or can't be equitable for example in case of interests' conflict with the Author or Organization is to advise the Editor requesting to exclude him or her from the process for reading this copy.

Author or group of Authors responsibilities (further on – Author). Requirements for the information submitted

The Author bares the responsibility for freshness, data adequacy of the research and article content which envisages adherence to the following principles:

- Do not allow works for publishing the major results of which have already been released or are planned for publication in different issues.

- The article Author is to provide valid and reliable data of the research completed. Prove black in white or incorrect contention is unacceptable. The publisher has the right to take away the article already published, if discovered, that during release someone's rights or adopted norms for the scientific Ethic have been ignored and violated. The fact of article withdrawal is to be advised to the author.
- The author is to present problems enumerated in article fully and objectively.
- The Author is to assure the research results in copy submitted are fully innovated. Any fragments derived or confirmations are to be arranged with obligatory Author's name and citation. The excessive derivation as well as plagiarism of any form, including citation, not arranged, paraphrasing or appropriation of rights involving other person's research is regarded not Ethic and not suitable for issue.
- All personnel endeavored on a large scale into the research obtained and reflected in article are to be named together with the article Authors. It's not allowed to name a person as co-Author not has taken part in research. The personnel endeavored greatly into the research submitted can be thanked and mentioned for the work well done within the article.
- The material submitted for the publication into the journal is to be approved and agreed by all Authors and relevant organizations involved into this work.
- If the Authors are many it is necessary to give contact information (address, telephone number, e-mail) of a person who to report to as well as other co-Authors.
- The Author should assure that in case the article is adopted for publication by the Journal can't be released by other Publishers with the same content neither in English nor in other languages including electronic version.
- The Author is forbidden to hide the interest' conflicts which can affect both the copy's mark and its interpretation as well as the project financial support source (grants, state programs, projects etc.,) and to be mentioned in mandatory manner.
- The Author detected major incorrect information in article submitted or have already been published is to immediately advise the publishing staff to adopt collaborated decision for the objective information presentation.
- The Author submitted the article for the Journal publication is to shape it in accordance to the rules stipulated by the Publisher. These are contained for the articles entered fully on the Journal web. site http://ssaa.ru/structur/riz/izvestia/treb_obrasez_rus.pdf
- The article is to be presented electronically and on a hard copy. Both copies are to be equal.

Publisher's rights

The Publisher doesn't make any correction work including artistic and grammar changes.

The Publisher has the right to reject the work which form has got deviation from current requirements and rules.

Copies and other supporting documents rejected and not published are not backed.

In documents adopted for publication the Publisher doesn't change the list and order of priority of Authors.

He chief Editor is responsible for issue conflicts elimination and settlement.

The materials submission for the Journal publication means concord with the rules and full presentation of the whole version of the copy in Internet and official site of the Journal and scientific electronic library <http://elibrary.ru> and in international base data AGRIS in free access both with using individual data in open publishing.
